## Minutes – March 21, 2019

Meeting called to order by Chairman Schwehr.

Motion by Carlblom, 2<sup>nd</sup> by Roorda to approve January 10, 2019 minutes. Motion carried.

Meeting recessed for the Hearing for BC Soil Conservation for a Variance of 75'-100' from the center of County Road 21, NE1/4 Lots C & D Eggerts Acres, 16-139-58, Marsh Township. No one appeared to protest. Jason Elston was present to explain the project to the board and to answer any questions. He stated that the building will be built 2 feet about the Base Flood Elevation so all the requirements needed by FEMA and our local floodplain permit will be met.
