The October meeting was called to order by Vice Chairman D. Olson at 8:20 am at the District Office in Valley City, ND. Minutes from the September 7th, 2016 board meeting were reviewed and Vice Chairman D. Olson declared those minutes approved as mailed.

FINANCIALS:

A list of receipts and bills paid during September 2016, along with the outstanding bills due from producers were reviewed by the Board. Stenson made a motion to accept the financial statement as presented with Nelson seconding it. All in favor aye. Motion carried.

CORRESPONDENCE:

- 1. November Annual Mtg agenda was distributed and registrations were finalized for all who are attending.
- 2. 2017-2019 Tech grant application was discussed, Jill will be submitting the new application when completed by Dec. 23, 2016
- 3. 2016 Tree Report was reviewed. At this time the hand plant tree charge and the tree planting/weed barrier charge were discussed. After discussion as to what other districts are charging, Nelson made a motion to increase the hand plant tree fee from \$1.50 to \$2.00 per tree and to set one rate for the trees and weed barrier installation to \$55.00 per hundred ft. (\$.55 per ft.) on all projects for weed barrier and \$30.00 per hundred feet (\$.30 per ft.) on all plantings. Stenson second the motion. All in favor aye. Motion carried.

REPORTS:

Office Report: DC Amanda Brandt discussed her attached report with the board. Cody Hoggarth, Farm Bill Specialist has been helping out more in the office along with Matt Shappell, Soil Conservationist from the Fargo office. Matt will be in the VC office 2 to 3 times a week.

Technician Report: Jason has been busy with tree plans for the upcoming tree season. He has been routing the drill around for later fall plantings for producers and has been water sampling for Lori. Jason has everything cleaned up at the shed and will drain the well soon since the temps have been dropping. He mowed at the park for the last time this year and rebuilt the bench.

Watershed Report: Lori was out of the office but Amanda and Jill went over her attached report. The board members are concerned about the declining balances in funds and the possibility of another grant to be written for 319 funds. More discussion will be had at the next board meeting with Lori.

OLD BUSINESS:

1. Salinity plot tour on September 21st was well attended with a lot of good questions and answers from the producers and speakers. Looking at setting up a winter grazing workshop again like last year at the Eagles club. The office staff will be working out those details later.

NEW BUSINESS:

- 1. NACD dues are due once again. Nelson made a motion to pay \$1000 in dues for the upcoming year which was the same as last year. Stenson second the motion. All in favor, aye. Motion carried.
- 2. Amanda reviewed the ranking criteria questions due for next week with the board. She also stated that one of the board members should be attending with her, if not, an appointed representative from the office should attend. That is to be decided later this week. Nelson made a motion to keep the existing questions to present at the upcoming meeting. Stenson second the motion. All in favor aye, motion carried.
