


PROGRAMS:

EQIP: 4,040.3 ac. to field check.

- Taking applications for FY 2019.
 - Currently meeting with producers on their land to go over their resource concerns.
 - o I have two more producers to meet out at their place to go over their resource concerns and FY2019 applications.
- Been going onsite to review installed practices and engineering that has been completed. Last week I checked out cover crops, pipeline, tanks, water well and a pump.

CSP: 22,661.2 ac. to field check.

- Following up with producers on enhancements that have been completed in 2018 so far.
 - o It has been a struggle since farmers haven't been able to harvest the crops for the most part.
 - I have been onsite half of the CSP contracts to check the cover crops planted. I plan on going in the field this week to look at more cover crops planted in 2018.

CRP: Cody Hoggarth and I have been reviewing CRP grass seeding paperwork & have to field check them yet this fall.

WRE: Nothing new.

Working Wetlands Program through Delta Waterfowl: 239 ac. to field check wetlands by November 16th.

Water Bank Program:

• Barnes County received funding for one ten-year contract.

• Area Office staff is coming to Valley City to review 5% of the engineering practices that were completed in 2018 in Barnes County.
