

The Board of Barnes County Commissioners met in regular session on Tuesday, February 3, 2004, with all members present.

Kerry Johnson, Barnes County Highway Superintendent, and Charlotte Brett from Kadrmas Lee & Jackson met with the Commission. Charlotte presented a letter of request from Kadrmas Lee & Jackson to move the bid letting for the 4<sup>th</sup> Street Bridge Project in Valley City from November 2004 to November 2006 in order to complete project studies. It was the consensus of the Board to change the date as requested.

Commissioner Berntson moved and Commissioner Maasjo seconded to exempt the Highway Department equipment operators and mechanic from the overtime rule for not counting holidays and vacations when considering overtime, to take effect immediately. Upon a roll call vote with all voting "Yes," motion carried.

Kerry presented the Federal Aid Contract and Contract Bond for the County summer projects as follows: AC-SC-0002(004)B, CP-0002(004)B, HSC-0221(063), & HSC-0221(064).

Commissioner Schwehr moved and Commissioner Opdahl seconded to sign the contract. Upon a roll call vote with all voting "Yes," motion carried.

Kerry presented quotes he received on emergency equipment for sanding.

Commissioner Opdahl moved and Commissioner Berntson seconded to allow Kerry to purchase a sand spreader for \$12,000.00 which will be paid for with FEMA funds. Upon a roll call vote with all voting "Yes," motion carried.

Kerry discussed the process his department uses for crack-sealing on County paved roads, and followed up with an explanation on the new process for crack-sealing which will last longer.

Kerry presented quotes on a commercial air compressor.

Commissioner Schwehr moved and Commissioner Maasjo seconded to approve Kerry purchasing a compressor and to demo and purchase a melter and miscellaneous equipment needed to proceed with the new method for crack-sealing. Costs will come from FEMA funds. Upon a roll call vote with all voting "Yes," motion carried.

Randy McClafin, Sheriff, introduce Kevin Schudar, Corrections, and the new Task Force Deputy.

Commissioner Maasjo moved and Commissioner Berntson seconded to approve the minutes of January 16 and 20, 2004, with corrections. Upon a roll call vote with all Commissioners voting "Yes", motion carried.

Commissioner Maasjo moved and Commissioner Berntson seconded to start the process for putting a Bridge Bond on the 2004 Primary Election Ballot. Upon a roll call vote with all Commissioners voting "Yes", motion carried.

Commissioner Maasjo moved and Commissioner Opdahl seconded to instruct the MIS Director to check out availability of computer hookups in the City-County Health Department if the Sheriff's Department was to be moved to that office, and what computer hookups and phones are available in the extra office at the County Shop including costs to make it compatible. Upon a roll call vote with all Commissioners voting "Yes", motion carried.
