

The Barnes County Commission met in a special budget session Tuesday, September 27, 2005, with all members present except Commissioner Triebold.

The Commission discussed budget options and changes with Ed McGough, County Auditor.

Discussion took place on the 5-mill request from the City-County Health Board.

Commissioner Maasjo made a motion, seconded by Commissioner Opdahl, to approve the 5 mills as requested by the City-County Health Board, and as allowed as the maximum mills for a health district, and to require that City-County Health pay back, within the first quarter of 2006, the \$48,000.00 loaned to them from the County General Fund in December of 2004. Upon a roll call vote with all members present voting "yes," motion carried.

There being no further business to come before the Board, Commissioner Maasjo made a motion, seconded by Commissioner Opdahl, to adjourn. Motion carried.
