

The Barnes County Commission met in special session Wednesday, December 14, 2005, to discuss the Assistant States Attorney position and the proposed joint correctional center.

States Attorney Brad Cruff discussed the resignation of Assistant States Attorney Jean Delaney, who accepted a position working with Robin Huseby for the state judicial system. Discussion centered on the need for a full-time assistant due to the increase in cases.

Commissioner Schwehr made a motion, seconded by Commissioner Berntson, to fill Delaney's position in the States Attorney's office, and to allow Cruff to hire for it at a maximum salary of \$45,000.00 per year, with benefits. Upon a roll call vote with all members voting "yes," motion carried.

Commissioner Schwehr made a motion, seconded by Commissioner Triebold, to accept Jean Delaney's resignation, effective December 23, 2005. Motion carried.

There being no further business to come before the Board, Commissioner Maasjo made a motion, seconded by Commissioner Schwehr, to adjourn. Motion carried.
