

The Barnes County Commission met in special session Thursday, November 9, 2006, with the following members present: Chairman Opdahl and Commissioners Schwehr and Berntson. The purpose of the meeting was to finalize the Commission-set minimum sale prices on County-acquired properties.

Auditor Edward McGough presented a letter requesting the following sale price changes from the cities of Valley City and Pillsbury:

- An increase of \$300 to Lots 4-6, Blk 1, Pillsbury (PCL:57-0010040); total price \$465
- An increase of \$200 to Lots 1 & 2, Blk 10, Pillsbury (PCL:57-0011150); total price \$2400
- An increase of \$600 to Part of NE ¼, less r/w 17-143-56, .84 acres, metes & bounds, Pillsbury (PCL: 57-0100130); total price \$1070
- An increase of \$300 to Part of NE ¼ NE ¼, less r/w 17-143-56, .10 acre, metes & bounds, Pillsbury (PCL:57-0100140); total price \$682
- An increase of \$284 to Lot 4, Blk 6, BW Benson's Addn, Valley City (PCL:63-0340800); total price \$7050
- An increase of \$48 to Lots 14-15, Blk 6, Less E 50', Riverside Park Addn, Valley City (PCL:63-4000827), total price, \$1578

Commissioner Schwehr made a motion, seconded by Commissioner Berntson, to accept the final sale prices, with above-noted changes. Motion carried.

There being no further business to come before the Board, Commissioner Berntson made a motion, seconded by Commissioner Schwehr, to adjourn. Motion carried.
