

The Barnes County Commission met in special session Thursday, September 28, 2007, with all members present.

Also present were Brad Cruff, States Attorney, and Betty Koslofsky, Tax Director.

The Board met to discuss State Board of Equalization's actions as to Barnes County's real property schedule of changes for the year 2007.

The abstract of the State Equalization Board's proceedings were reviewed by those present.

After much discussion, Commissioner Berntson made a motion, seconded by Triebold, to change at least one (1) acre of agricultural land to residential land, under all taxable residential structures. Upon a roll call vote with Berntson and Triebold voting "yes," and Schwehr, Opdahl, and Weber voting "no," motion failed.

There being no further business to come before the Board, Commissioner Weber made a motion, seconded by Triebold, to adjourn. Motion carried.
