

The Barnes County Commission met in special session Tuesday, October 30, 2007, with all members present except Chairman Schwehr.

Vice-chair Triebold opened the meeting, which was a hearing to allow cities and townships to amend the minimum sale prices on tax-delinquent properties previously set by the Commission.

Auditor Ed McGough presented a letter from the City of Leal, requesting to increase the price of PCL: 53-0010165 from \$100 to \$300, citing specials incurred by mowing and cleanup.

Commissioner Berntson made a motion, seconded by Opdahl, to increase the sale price of PCL: 53-0010165 from \$100 to \$300, to compensate for the 2007 specials of \$200. Upon a roll call vote with all members present voting "yes," motion carried.

There being no further business to come before the Board, Commissioner Opdahl made a motion, seconded by Weber, to adjourn. Motion carried.
