

The Barnes County Commission met in special session Friday, December 28, 2007, with all members present.

The Commission reviewed 2007 budgets which were overspent and discussed the reasons. They noted that most of the overspent budgets were due to grant dollars acquired during the year; the Gibbs trial, and road and bridge projects which were completed to take advantage of state and federal money available during the 2007 construction season.

Commissioner Triebold made a motion, seconded by Berntson, to amend the following 2007 County budgets. Upon a roll call vote with all members voting "yes," motion carried.

States Attorney: \$175,871.00 amended to 194,959.41; **City-County Health:** \$793,660.00 to 822,792.65; **County Park:** \$45,680.00 to 63,875.80; **Emergency:** \$25,000.00 to 42,247.06; **Advertising:** \$20,151.00 to 26,410.43; **Farm to Market:** \$840,750.00 to 1,158,291.13; **Corrections:** \$408,852.00 to 481,425.35; **County Bridge:** \$422,199.00 to 632,985.20; **Water Resource:** \$69,650.00 to 83,624.19.

There being no further business to come before the Board, Commissioner Opdahl made a motion, seconded by Triebold, to adjourn. Motion carried.
