

The Barnes County Commission met in special session Tuesday, March 25, 2008, with the following members present: Chairman Schwehr, Commissioners Opdahl, Berntson, and Triebold; and absent, Weber.

Chairman Schwehr opened the meeting at 8:15 a.m.

Commissioner Opdahl made a motion, seconded by Berntson, to recess the meeting and enter into executive session. Upon a roll call vote with all members present voting "yes," motion carried.

A conference call was made to John Warcup, attorney representing the County in the Roger and Michelle Triebold abatement case in District Court.

Mr. Warcup updated the Commission on the District Court decision in favor of the Triebolds and the County's options on how to proceed.

Commissioner Opdahl made a motion, seconded by Berntson, to close the executive session at 9 a.m. Upon a roll call vote with all members present voting "yes," motion carried.

Chairman Schwehr reconvened the Commission meeting.

Commissioner Berntson made a motion, seconded by Opdahl, to ask the District Court to reconsider the Roger and Michelle Triebold 2005 abatement application decision. Upon a roll call vote with all members present voting "yes," motion carried.

There being no further business to come before the Board, Commissioner Triebold made a motion, seconded by Berntson, to adjourn. Motion carried.
