Special Meeting

The Barnes County Commission met in special session Friday, May 22, 2009, with all members present except Commissioner Opdahl, who was absent. Also present were Ken Ried, county FEMA representative, and Kim Franklin, EMA.

Ms. Franklin asked that the County inform the Corps of Engineers of dike removal needs, as they will be finished with their mission by August 24.

Commissioner Froelich made a motion, seconded by Weber, that the County asks the Corps of Engineers remove the County dikes in Woodland Park that were constructed during the 2009 flood, with the only cost being the 3 percent cost share. Upon a roll call vote with all present voting "yes," motion carried.

Discussion took place concerning the possibility of the County creating a building inspector position.

There being no further business to come before the Board, Commissioner Weber made a motion, seconded by Froelich, to adjourn. Motion carried.
