

Barnes County Commission – Special Meeting
Monday, July 27, 2009
Valley City, North Dakota

The Barnes County Commission met in a special bid-opening session Monday, July 27, 2009 with all members present except Commissioner Schwehr.

One bid was submitted for the Peak Road project, from Border States Paving, Jamestown, for \$367,064.39.

Commissioner Opdahl made a motion, seconded by Froelich, to accept the only bid received, from Border States Paving, Jamestown, for the amount of \$367,064.39, for repairs to 4 miles of Highway 27 (Peak Road) located seven miles south. Upon a roll call vote with all present voting “yes,” motion carried.

Discussion took place on the concerns of a resident regarding a county culvert. Kerry Johnson, Highway Superintendent, is working on this concern.

There being no further business to come before the Board, Commission Froelich made a motion, seconded by Opdahl, to adjourn. Motion carried.
