

Special Meeting - Barnes County Commission
Wednesday, August 5, 2009
Valley City, North Dakota

The Barnes County Commission met in special session Wednesday, August 5, 2009, with all members present. Also attending were the following: Kerry Johnson, Highway Superintendent; Bev Anderson, Parks Superintendent; Kim Franklin, Emergency Manager; Brad Cruff, States Attorney; Dale Maasjo, Park Board Chairman; Mark Anderson, KLJ; Steve Urness, KOVC; and Jean Schlegel, Times-Record.

Chairman Berntson opened the meeting. A telephone conference call with Pam Gulleon of Sen. Dorgan's office was held.

Discussion took place on the separation of Clausen Springs Park and the dam.

It was the consensus of the Board that the Commission and Park Board are taking responsibility of damages to the Park only, such as for roads, electrical outlets, and outbuildings.

After discussion, it was determined that the Highway Department and Park Board have all FEMA information submitted and updated.

Mr. Johnson stated he is waiting for federal funding eligibility determination for two grade raises. The sites are under water on the both sides of Highway 1 on County Road 10 (Old 10) west of Valley City.

There being no further business to come before the Board, Commissioner Weber made a motion, seconded by Opdahl, to adjourn. Motion carried.
