

The Barnes County Commission met in special session Wednesday, October 28, 2009, with all members present.

Chairman Berntson opened the meeting, then recessed it and opened a hearing on the prices set on the delinquent tax properties.

With no one present to speak for or against the minimum sale prices set by the Commission, Chairman Berntson closed the hearing and reconvened the Commission meeting.

Commissioner Opdahl made a motion, seconded by Weber, to approve the amounts as set, and that the listed properties be sold at auction the third Tuesday in November (November 17), at 11 a.m. Motion carried.

Auditor Ed McGough presented a request from the U.S. Census Bureau that Barnes County include a census information flier with the tax statements.

It was the consensus of the Commission that the fliers be included as requested.

There being no further business to come before the Board, Commissioner Weber made a motion, seconded by Opdahl, to adjourn. Motion carried.
