

Special Meeting - Barnes County Commission
Friday, November 6, 2009
Valley City, North Dakota

The Barnes County Commission met in special session Friday, November 6, 2009, with all members present.

Chairman Berntson opened the meeting, then recessed it and opened a hearing on the prices set on the delinquent tax properties.

Auditor Ed McGough presented a letter from the City of Valley City requesting a price increase for specials to two parcels on the delinquent tax properties list.

With no one else present to speak for or against the minimum sale prices set by the Commission, Chairman Berntson closed the hearing and reconvened the Commission meeting.

Commissioner Schwehr made a motion, seconded by Opdahl, to approve the amounts as set, and that the listed properties be sold at auction the third Tuesday in November (November 17), in the Barnes County Courthouse Commission chambers, at 11 a.m. Motion carried.

There being no further business to come before the Board, Commissioner Schwehr made a motion, seconded by Opdahl, to adjourn. Motion carried.
