Barnes County Wildlife Federation would like to build a 12x24 picnic shelter on a cement pad at Faust Park. John Froelich moved to approve the request, pending verification that this is within the requirements set forth by FEMA; Cindy Schwehr seconded the motion. Motion carried upon roll-call vote, with all members voting "yes".

Stan Horst, Building & Grounds, updated the Commission on interior repairs and painting that were recently completed and discussed the remaining repair budget.

## <u> Highway – Bid Award Resolution</u>

Kerry Johnson, Highway Superintendent, presented a bid award Resolution for approval. Cindy Schwehr moved to adopt Resolution 2020-1; Vicky Lovell seconded the motion. Motion carried upon roll-call vote, with all members voting "yes".
