Chairman Carlblom called the meeting to order at 7:30 a.m., roll-call was taken, the Pledge of Allegiance was recited, a tour of third floor courthouse office space was taken. The agenda was reviewed upon return from the office space tour.

Emergency Management

Jessica Jenrich presented information on Severe Summer Weather Awareness week which is designated as April 22nd through April 26th. A drill will be done sometime during the week with the tornado sirens being set off. Plans are still being made. Dispatch will send out a notice on Everbridge. The Times Record and News Dakota will be notified. Businesses, schools, and counties will be notified. Jessica would like to implement county wide fire and tornado drills again.

Auditor – Minutes

Vicky Lovell moved to approve the March 19, 2024 minutes; Shawn Olauson seconded the motion. Motion carried with all members voting yes. Vicky Lovell moved to approve the Local Raffle Permit for Barnes County North School District; Cindy Schwehr seconded the motion. Motion carried unanimously upon roll call vote. County Government Month is the month of April. Barnes County Commission set County Government Week as April 15 through April 19th. The county will serve Walking Taco's and Ice Cream floats on Tuesday April 16th from 11:00 a.m. to 1:00 p.m.

Commission Discussion

Pete Paulson reported we have another applicant for the VSO position and will set up interviews. There are also two applicants for the part time VSO driver opening. We need to get help up at the VSO even if it's just answering phones and helping Tammy out until we fill the position. The Development Corporation meeting will be next Monday. Shawn Olauson reported that we will need to appoint a Water District Manager. Shawn attended the Township Officers meeting which was good. He also attended the County Summit meeting in Bismarck which was also very good. Topics discussed were property tax elimination and shared services regarding combining offices. Wes at the museum wants to know what the county will do if anything for the Barnes County 150th Centennial. The county will put a full-page ad in the Centennial book. Crissy Drake at Dispatch will design an ad to put in the book. Vicky Lovell reported HUD Housing had someone come in to evaluate their boiler and cooling system. MC3000 oil that the Highway Department uses to do chip overlay is no longer made. Jamie will attend a conference in Bismarck to see what the available alternatives are. Equipment no longer used will be put out on bids. Bill Carlblom has meetings coming up next week.

States Attorney

The lawyer handling conflicts cases has taken a full-time job offer in Bismarck and is no longer able to help Tonya with conflict cases. Tonya would like to hire another lawyer at the same rate as the previous lawyer to help with those cases that are conflicts. There are no applicants for an Assistant States Attorney at the increased hiring rate. She would like to attend another training conference in June applicable to a case she is working on and would like permission to attend. This training will be in Louisville Kentucky. Cindy Schwehr moved to approve Tonya attending the training in Louisville Kentucky; Pete Paulson seconded the motion. Motion carried with Cindy, Bill, and Pete voting yes and Vicky and Shawn voting no. Ways to reach outside our boundaries were discussed to try to find applicants. Finding applicants is a statewide issue. Tonya is getting overworked and stressed without an Assistant States Attorney. Office remodeling was discussed to give the States Attorney's office more room and more security. Cindy Schwehr made a motion to raise the Assistant State Attorney's hiring wage to \$100,000; Vicky Lovell seconded the motion. Motion carried with all members voting yes. Tonya would like additional compensation of \$50,000.00 for carrying the extra workload for the extended period. There is three months of this year that has not been spent on payroll for an Assistants States Attorney which would be available from her budget. This will be tabled until the next commission meeting.
