Clausen Springs Recreation Area

19 electrical 50/30/20 amp sites – 27 non-electrical campsites

Park:

- 1) Purchase 4 8' picnic tables and place as applicable (1 picnic table north of center loop shelter, add one table and ring north/northeast of center shelter, 1 in Sleepy Hollow (manager special has extra table) 1 in Gussie Curve, one under the shelter by the shop)
- 2) Purchase and install 6 -7"h rings (Sage Drive, Lookout/overlook needs approach and fire ring, add a ring north/northeast of center shelter
- 3) Repair picnic tables and stain old posts as applicable
- 4) Level trenches established by 2014 electrical upgrades, add topsoil & seed
- 5) Clean out cans, bottles, plastic debris in outhouses
- 6) Add drain tile to drain around shelter south of bathhouse
- 7) Paint swing set by NE concrete privy
- 8) Repair merry go round
- 9) Repair or remove swing set by merry go round
- 10) Clean out shop, install rack to get tools/inventories off floor to prevent future flood damage
- 11) Paint 2nd coat on plywood ceilings that were replaced on two shelters
- 12) Treat cattails just south of small fishing dock

Major improvements:

- Add gravel and place dumpster by dump station, eliminate/reduce garbage cans in shop loop and center campsite area to boat landing (evaluate keeping cans at shelters)
- Install 15' drain pipe for Hide away campsite access directly south of 4 large power campsites
- Add new electrical pedestals one north and one south of center shelter
- Dig around north/west side of shop so water does not run into building, shape & seed
- Remove large tree in the playground site
- Install 3 large rock around creek hydrant
- Remove, resize and install storage lot fence behind shop (posts rotted off)
- Replace southeast pair of wood outhouses with new single concrete privy
- Add asphalt lift to shop loop and roads through middle of campsite area to boat landing
- Install Rural Water-revise culvert for shutoff for shower house water supply
- Design, purchase and install playground equipment

Signage/Mapping both parks:

- 1) Review and laminate printed materials in bulletin cases.
- KLJ creating a Park map of campsites with numbers identifying electrical and primitive sites and other campground amenities

Weed Board:

 Spray by spillway turnaround and in park as requested by Bev, including several burn rings infested with Canada thistle

Other/Pending:

Fishing dock: BC Wildlife consider adding a fishing dock extension;

Wood outhouses: Complete minor wood, screen, shingle and paint repairs

Shop: Insulate, replace overhead door with insulated door or foam insulate door, install a furnace

Little Yellowstone Park

9 (50/30/20 amp pedestals, 3 - 20 amp pedestals and 4 - 30/20 amp sites 20 non-electrical)

Park:

- 1. Spigot by large shelter is partially plugged
- 2. Purchase & install 13-7"h fire rings (add a ring south of campsite 1, add ring at new campsite south of metal footbridge and replace burn rings in west primitive sites)
- 3. Add a new 8' picnic table at new site south of metal footbridge
- 4. Level trenches established by 2014 electrical upgrades, add topsoil & seed
- 5. Clean out cans, bottles, plastic debris in outhouses
- 6. Replace ball diamond top back stop fence board and stain
- 7. Repair picnic tables and stain old posts and tables as applicable
- 8. Repair south approach to steel footbridge & 2x4 guard rail (stain replacement rail)
- 9. Repair steps by box culvert
- 10. Concrete repair on east creek crossing
- 11. Replace 2 rotten power pedestal poles
- 12. Trim trees/brush along roadways, fill pot holes with gravel in primitive loops

Major Improvements:

Add culvert loop road to allow drainage
Add gravel under eves of shelters as applicable
Install Rural Water
Concrete Privy/Shower House
Asphalt Road Repairs
Replace/relocate shelters and install concrete

Signage/Mapping both parks:

Concrete Privy Kathryn Dam:
