Barnes County Park Board Thursday, May 5, 2016 Barnes County Courthouse

The Barnes County Park Board met in regular session on Thursday, May 5, 2016. The following were present: Bobby Koepplin, Kerry Johnson, Bill Carlblom, Mike Metcalf, John Froelich, and Andre Delorme. Also present was Bev Anderson.

Park Board Chairman Bobby Koepplin called the meeting to order at 7:00 am, and the agenda was reviewed. Mike Metcalf moved to approve the agenda, John Froelich seconded the motion. Motion carried.

John Froelich moved to approve the April 14, 2016 minutes; Bill Carlblom seconded the motion. Motion carried.

John Froelich moved to accept the April year-to-date financials as presented; Bill Carlblom seconded the motion. Motion carried.

REPORTS/UPDATES: Grant Updates: The Heritage Playground Grant for \$10,000 was denied. The Garrison grant for \$21,855 was approved. Only \$500 of the \$5,000 ADM grant was approved; will apply again this fall.

OLD BUSINESS: Paving updates – hopefully will be done by the end of next week. John Froelich made a motion to implement a reservation system as presented with a \$5 fee; Mike Metcalf seconded the motion. Motion carried. Plans for the 50th Anniversary celebration and a \$1,000 contract for Blind Joe were discussed.

NEW BUSINESS: Rural Water will cost \$17,566. A sky light quote from Enterprise in the amount of \$1,460 was discussed. John Froelich made a motion to approve the paving, 3 privies, and rural water at a cost to the County of \$93,421; Kerry Johnson seconded the motion. Motion carried. Playground equipment will be decided upon later in the year. Mike Metcalf moved to have the park season run from May 1st through October 31st, and the Park Manager be employed from April 9 through November 8th (Bobby will update the Park Manager Job Description to reflect the change. John Froelich seconded the motion. Motion carried. Bev Anderson presented a park update, Board consensus to allow flower planting around flag pole. Bev noted a tree needs to be removed.

PENDING: Carsonite install all nonelectrical sites & re-numbering as applicable per maps; Apply for SERVE and Dickey Rural grants; Shower House at Little Yellowstone.

Bill Carlblom moved to adjourn: Mike Metcalf seconded the motion, Motion carried, and the meeting adjourned.
