## **Commission Discussion**

John Froelich reported that it appears that all of the Sanborn Lake outlet easements will be able to be obtained at a reasonable cost. Cindy Schwehr and Bill Carlblom updated the Commission on the duties and processes of the Sheriff's Office Deputy. Eckelson Lake Snagging and Clearing has improved the flowage and will continue to be monitored and cattails will be sprayed, as needed.
