

The Barnes County Commission met in special session on Wednesday, August 11, 2021 with Vicky Lovell and Bill Carblom, present, in person, and Cindy Schwehr, via TEAMS. Pete Paulson and Shawn Olauson were unable to attend. Chairman Carblom called the meeting to order at 8:00 a.m., the Pledge of Allegiance was recited, and the Agenda was reviewed.

Commissary Account Set-up & Authorizations
