

2010 BARNES COUNTY ROAD RESTRICTIONS

SPEED:

All trucks traveling on highways with a gross weight of more than 10,000 lbs. will be restricted to a maximum speed limit of 35 miles per hour when posted.

WEIGHT RESTRICTION:

All trucks traveling on Barnes County roads are limited as follows:

Load limit of 12,000 lbs. per steering axle, 20,000 lbs. per single axle, and 34,000 lbs. per tandem axle will be in effect on the following roads:

- From I-94 2¼ miles north to the city of Sanborn
- From City limits of Valley City north ¼ mile to the North Valley Elevator on Co. Rd. #21.
- From Oakes Interchange on I-94 northwest on Old #10(Co. Rd.#22) to Berea, 1½ miles.
- County Road #34 - from State Hwy. #32 east 1 mile into the city of Fingal.
- County Road #11 – from State Hwy. #46 north 1½ miles into the city of Litchville.
- From Peak Interchange on I-94, north 6 ½ miles.
- From I-94 at Exit #290, south ¼ mile.
- From Valley City south at the Kathryn Interchange ½ mile.
- From State Hwy. #1 at Rogers west on Co. Rd. #11 ¼ mile.
- From State Hwy. #9 north ¾ mile into the city of Leal.
- From State Hwy. #26 north 2 miles on county road #27.

All motor vehicles or any other object traveling on all Barnes County gravel roads are limited to 15,000 lbs. per axle, and in no case shall 550 lbs. per inch tire width be exceeded.

All motor vehicles or any moving object traveling on all other Barnes County roads will not scale over 6 tons per axle, nor shall the weight per inch of tire width exceed 550 lbs.

Maximum Gross weights on county roads are 80,000.

EXCEPTIONS TO WEIGHT RESTRICTIONS:

1. Unlicensed, full flotation fertilizer applicators may obtain a permit.
2. No permit is needed for a farming implement traveling less than 30 miles per hour which is being used for agricultural tillage only.
3. Other permits are available on a limited basis from the Barnes County Highway Department based on emergency circumstances.
4. For purpose of road restriction compliance and enforcement, the term “traveling upon or on a highway” shall not be construed to encompass a vehicle merely crossing from one side of the road or highway to the other side at regular intersection or established road crossing.

Permits are available only at the Barnes County Highway department, Valley City, North Dakota (701) 845-8508. Permits must be carried in the vehicle designated in the permit.

However, if road conditions deteriorate, the Barnes County Highway Department or Barnes County Commission may further restrict travel in certain areas.

Fees for permits

1. ALL ROADS:

- A. Commercial full flotation fertilizer applicators - \$50.00 per season.
- B. Single trips - \$20.00 per permit

ROAD RESTRICTIONS WILL TAKE EFFECT AT THE DISCRETION OF THE BARNES COUNTY HIGHWAY ROAD SUPERINTENDENT.
