

Camping Fees

1 unit per campsite

(1 unit = a RV or Camper plus a tent or two tents)
Maximum of 8 people per site

Electrical Sites: \$20.00 per night

Non-electrical Sites: \$15.00 per night

Campfires, Wood & Toilets

The Park sells approved firewood. Price is \$5.00 per bundle. **Do not move fire rings!**

Wood can also be picked up from the Campground Host at Clausen Springs.

Only local or certified wood is allowed within the Park.

By order of the Barnes County Park Board:

Please make sure all wood is free of NAILS or any pieces of metal before you use it in campfires.

DO NOT put bottles/cans in fire pits or toilets.

Registration Requirements

Completing the Registration

Please register immediately.

Complete **all** information on the registration form. Detach white copy, place payment in envelope and deposit into the registration box.

Display the White Copy of Registration

Attach your white registration form to the respective campsite marker.

Park representatives typically make rounds twice a day to check registrations and sell firewood!

Clausen Springs Campground Regulations

- Quiet hours are 11:00 PM to 7:00 AM
- Camping is limited to no more than 7 days in one location.
- No unattended campsite for more than 24 hours is allowed.
- No burning except in fire pits.
- Metal detecting and digging are prohibited.
- Use of firearms within campgrounds is prohibited. The Wildlife Management Area is open to hunting during respective seasons.
- No washing of fish or dishes is allowed at public fountains. Please be respectful of others.
- Speed limit within the camping areas is 10 miles per hour. Outside camping areas the posted speed limit is 25 miles per hour.
- Anyone operating a motor vehicle in the park must be 16 years of age and be a licensed driver.
- Use of charcoal burners on picnic tables is prohibited.
- Cutting, damaging, or destroying any trees within the park is prohibited.
- Please do not interfere with park staff, employees or Campground Hosts doing their jobs.
- All pets must be leashed within the park area.
- No horses are allowed within the park.
- No ATV or dirt bike riding is allowed.
